Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: YEAR 3 Trip to Butser Ancient Farm

We are going to be experiencing the life of people during the Stone, Bronze and Iron Age. When arriving at Butser Ancient Farm, we will be having our own unique educational experience into the lives of these early people. We will be carrying out a number of activities including fire making/lighting, making natural cordage, archaeology digging and a guided tour.

DATE: **Tuesday 25th November 2025**

TIME: Depart from school at 9.00am (please arrive in time for registration)

Returning to school in time for the normal end of the school day

DRESS: Old clothes rather than uniform. Lots of layers which can be added or taken off. Woolly hats, thick gloves and scarves if weather will be cold. Strong, old shoes or trainers are warmer than wellington boots on cold days. Wellington boots are good if it is very wet as it can get very muddy there. Warm waterproof clothing for wet and cold days. The wind can whip through the site, meaning that a thick jumper is not enough.

FOOD: Please send your child in with a packed lunch in disposable containers.
No glass please.
Alternatively, you can order a school picnic lunch.
